The Partner Bank List does not necessarily identify the order of the Partner Banks that receive funds swept from your High Yield Cash Account. To find out the deposit sequence applicable to you, please contact Public Investing at [support@public.com](mailto:support@public.com).

You may not change the order in which the Partner Banks on this list receive your funds. However, you may, at any time, designate a Partner Bank as ineligible to receive funds from your High-Yield Cash Account by contacting Public Investing at [support@public.com](mailto:support@public.com). You may want to exclude a Partner Bank, for example, if you have funds at a Partner Bank outside of the High-Yield Cash Account program and your aggregate deposits at that Partner Bank may exceed FDIC coverage limits. If you designate a Partner Bank as ineligible to receive your funds and, at that time, you already have funds allocated to that Partner Bank, Apex Clearing will remove your funds from that Partner Bank and allocate them to another Partner Bank. Please note that a reduction of the available Partner Banks will reduce the amount of aggregate FDIC insurance available to you. **You are responsible for monitoring the total amount of deposits that you have at a bank to determine the amount of FDIC insurance you may have available to you.**

Partner Banks may be added or removed from the Partner Bank List. When changes are made, we will update the Partner bank List available at <https://public.com/disclosures/high-yield-account/partners-list>. Where practical, we will endeavor to give you at least 30 days’ notice of any such change. However, under certain limited circumstances, such prior notification may not be possible.
