

Reverse Split Trading Fee Disclosures

When you purchase stock that will be subject to a reverse split, and you subsequently sell that stock within the 10 days following the reverse split, Open to the Public Investing, Inc. (“Public Investing”) may charge an administrative fee on your sale.

At the point of purchase, we will let you know if your stock may be subject to the fee and the amount of the fee. The fee won’t be assessed until you sell the stock, and only applies if you sell it within 10 days of the reverse split.

What is a reverse stock split?

A reverse stock split is a corporate action that consolidates the number of existing shares of a company’s stock into fewer shares with a proportionally higher share price. The total market value of the company remains unchanged.

Why am I being charged a fee?

We charge a fee to cover the costs associated with the expedited processing and management of the corporate action. This fee is waived for Premium members.
